

Background

The Scottish Palliative care guidelines (SPCG) content aims to give practical advice to clinicians who encounter patients with palliative care needs. The guidelines started life as paper documents, moving onto an umbraco website in the early 2010s. A separate app was developed by West of Scotland University which hosted a limited number of guidelines. In 2022, there was a strategic review of the guidelines, including commissioning of a digital scoping with option appraisal.

AIM

To develop a more accessible, flexible website and application for the SPCG.

Method

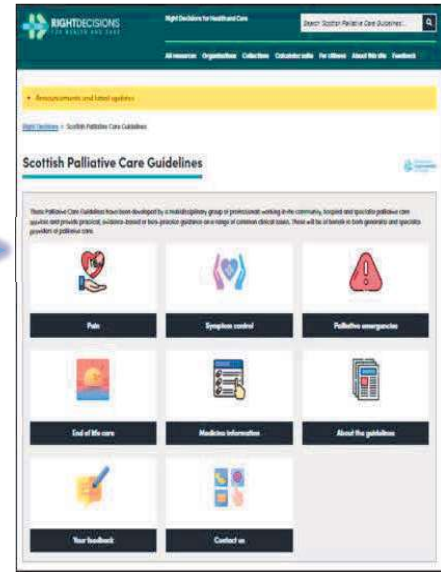
The guidelines group supported the option to host the guidelines on the Right Decision Service (RDS) website and application. The first step was to transfer the guideline content to the new application by the RDS team, adapting sections to meet the new format. The guidelines group reviewed content, updated with agreed amendments along with changes to medicines license status. This is to be followed with a programme of development to utilise the added value features of RDS.

Discussion

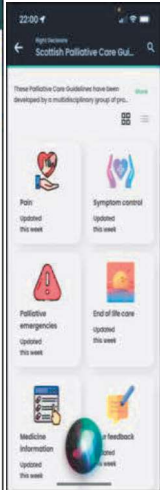
The full range of guidelines materials are available on and offline to professionals, patients and carers. A faster, modernised format searchable interface makes it easier to implement and use validated evidence in day-to-day patient care implementing principles of realistic medicine. Partial loss of highlighted features such as colour coded risk management of medicines leaflets is receiving attention. A review cycle of the SPCG will enable content to utilise advanced features of RDS more effectively such as decision support. Feedback from end users is welcomed.
